



EditMule Auto Scratch READ ME

EDITMULE Auto Scratch (EMAS). Version 2.0, May 16th 2010

EMAS is an application that allows you to make your Final Cut Pro system settings project specific. It remembers all scratch disk locations even when you hop between projects.

New to this version

Now compatible with versions 5, 6 and 7 of Final Cut Pro, as well as version 10.6 of the Mac Operating System (Snow Leopard).

Minimum System Requirements

- A Macintosh computer with a 1.25GHz or faster PowerPC G4, PowerPC G5, Intel Core Duo, or Intel Xeon processor
- 1GB of RAM
- Mac OS X v10.4.11 or Mac OS X v10.5.5 or later
- Final Cut Pro 5.0 or higher

Installation notes

- This DMG contains a demo version of EMAS that expires 14 days from installation. If you choose to buy EMAS after the trial period is over please either follow the instructions to buy the app, or visit www.editmule.com. Upon purchase you will receive a serial that will activate your app and lock it to the machine you have installed it to.

Known issues / Limitations

- If you create a project that has the same name as a previous project EMAS will not automatically launch when the project is opened. EMAS will also use the scratch location used for the original project (If it still exists). If you want to change the scratch location you will need to 'Modify Link' in the file menu.
- Scratch disk locations do not update when you hop between projects in your browser, only in the finder.
- Upgrading / downgrading versions of FCP whilst using EMAS will result in links breaking. They will need to be recreated in order to continue using the plugin.
